

How are Points Calculated

Points are calculated from a set of multipliers applied to a receipt's eligible subtotal. The variables and rules below define exactly how the number of points earned is determined.

Variables

- **m_status** — the user's status multiplier (max 2×)
- **m_plus** — the user's subscription multiplier (max 2×)
- **m_loc** — the location's point multiplier
- **s** — the receipt subtotal, minus any applicable discounts and before tax
- **m_user** — the combined user multiplier, where $m_user = m_status \times m_plus$

How points are calculated

The number of points earned depends on whether the location has a special multiplier:

1. **Location has no multiplier** — when $m_loc = 1$: $points = (m_status \times m_plus) \times s$
2. **Location multiplier only** — when $m_loc > 1$ and $m_status = m_plus = 1$: $points = m_loc \times s$
3. **Location multiplier + user bonus** — when $m_loc > 1$ and either $m_status > 1$ or $m_plus > 1$: $points = (m_loc + (m_status \times m_plus)) \times s$

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
